

Why Terriers are like Military Recon Units

- Their primary mission is to find out what's out there, report back, and then let the big dogs deal with it
- They are small (this facilitates concealment)
- They are fast and highly maneuverable (easier to run from hideout to hideout, while simultaneously avoiding being caught)
- They have highly-tuned sensors (multispectral) so they don't miss anything
- They have excellent communication systems (to tell their superiors what's out there. Or that **something's** out there that ain't right, anyway)
- They have minimal armor (since their main goal is to warn of trouble rather than engage the "enemy" themselves)
- They have minimal armament (adequate to provide defense if cornered, but light and compact enough to facilitate a swift retreat)
- When push comes to shove, they **will** fight above their weight class
